

EDQM BLOOD CONFERENCE

Abstract submission guidelines

Dates: 14 – 15 January 2025

Location: Strasbourg, France

1. Submission requirements:

- Originality: must be unpublished and not presented elsewhere.
- Intent to attend: submit only if available to present in person.
- Review process: abstracts will be assessed by the international Scientific Committee.
- Registration: **authors of accepted abstracts must register within two weeks of acceptance notification.**

The EDQM reserves the right to remove from publication any abstract whose author does not fulfil these requirements.

2. Deadlines:

- Abstract submission deadline: **15 July 2024 23.59 hours (CEST).**
- Notification of acceptance/rejection: October 2024.

3. Selection criteria:

Selection will be made by the EDQM and the international scientific committee in charge of the programme of the conference, according to the criteria listed below.

Authors are specifically encouraged to take quality management aspects into consideration.

- Relevance to conference themes.
- Clarity of expressed scientific inquiry and findings.
- Adherence to formatting and structural guidelines.

4. Rejection criteria:

Abstracts will be rejected in the following cases:

- Prior publication/presentation, lack of new data.
- Insufficient data, patient confidentiality breach.
- Unsupported conclusions, commercial bias, poor presentation quality.

5. Publication of abstracts:

Accepted abstracts will be published online and included in the conference's abstract book prior to the event.

6. Submission process:

- Visit the [EDQM blood conference – call for abstracts](#) page to start your submission.
- Click on "[complete your abstract submission form](#)". The tool will take you through the process step-by-step. You can access your form and upload a new version of your abstract as often as necessary before the final submission.
- Ensure final submission by pressing the 'SUBMIT' button. A confirmation email will be sent.
